9. Rail: NEW


Supplies:

- Rail mount with four C-Channels
 - · Supplied hardware

Installation Steps:

- 1. Locate sturdy railing
- 2. Insert two bolts into the top holes of the footplate*
- Slide one C-channel onto the bolts (flat side facing footplate)
- 4. Hold the assembly at the railing location
- 5. Slide the second C-channel onto the bolts
- 6. Thread nuts onto each of the bolts and handtighten
- 7. Repeat steps for the bottom section
- 8. Level the mast and tighten hardware with
- 9. 7/16" wrench
- *If installation is on the outside of the railing, keep the bolts facing out





9. Rail: OLD

Supplies:

- Rail mount (plates 1, 2, 3)
- Supplied hardware

Assembly Steps:

- 1. Lay out all plates and hardware
- 2. Put plate 1 on plate 2 0-
- 3. Put locking washer and 1 1/2" bolt through holes of plates 1 and 2
- 4. Place plate 3 onto plates 1 and 2 assembly O-
- 5. Lightly tighten nuts (for transport)
- Place locking washer and nuts on plate 3, lightly tighten (for transport)

Installation Steps:

- 1. Locate sturdy railing
- 2. Disassemble plate 3 from plates 1 and 2
- 3. Clamp plates 1 and 2 around rail
- 4. Insert plate 3 on bolts of 1 and 2 0-
- 5. Level the rail mount
- 6. Tighten nuts with 7/16" wrench
- 7. Attach footplate to plate 3 with locking washers and nuts
- 8. Level mast and tighten hardware with 7/16" wrench
- 9. Place dish on mast









10. Non-Pen

Supplies:

- · Non-pen mount base
- · Supplied hardware

Assembly Steps:

- 1. Take out mount
- 2. Attach mast/footplate to mount, so LNBF will be opposite ballast
- 3. Take out appropriate number of blocks

Installation Steps:

- 1. Locate suitable location
- 2. Transport mount, mat, and blocks
- 3. Place mat on mounting location
- 4. Place mount on mat
- 5. Place cap blocks on mount
- 6. Level mast and tighten hardware with
- 7. 7/16" wrench
- 8. Place dish on mast

11. VERSATILE™

Supplies:

- VERSATILE™ mount
- · Supplied hardware



Assembly Steps:

- 1. Align the footplate with the base plate
- 2. Use the supplied hardware to attach footplate

Installation Steps:

- 1. Locate a suitable mounting location
 - Two rows from the edge
 - Clear 2' on all sides of mount
 - No broken/damaged tiles
- 2. Lift the tile in the row above ____
- 3. Slide the support tongue until it hooks on the tile below
- 4. Lower the tile and repeat with other support tongue
- 5. Place the base in selected location
- 6. Lift the tile that the base is sitting on and slide the hooks under the tile
- 7. Place stiffener bar on top of the tongue O
- Insert the bolt through the base plate, support tongue, and stiffener bar
- 9. Place a locking washer and nut on the bolt
- Tighten with 7/16" wrench until the mast is level (do not over tighten)
- 11. Place dish on mast







13. Pole: Preparation

Supplies:

- Non-Pen mount
- Cap blocks
- Burial cable
- Sweep
- · White flags
- · 3' jumper with barrel and terminator

Assembly Steps:

- 1. Route burial cable through sweep
- 2. Attach burial cable and jumper to LNBF

Installation Steps:

- 1. Place non-pen mount in pole mount location
- 2. Route orange burial cable to house, leaving 5' of extra cable near dish
- 3. Place flags at mount site, along burial cable, and in a backup location
 - Backup location should be 7' to 10' away
 - Flags spaced every 6' and inserted 4" deep
 - Minimum of three flags per location
- 4. Finish the installation
- 5. Call DigSafe (811), get date and confirmation number (during receiver download)
- 6. Talk to customer about pole mount appointment
- 7. Call CSC to set up new work order

12. Patio

Supplies:

- Patio mount
- Rubber mat (if mount does not have rubber base)
- Cap blocks

Assembly Steps:

- 1. Take out mount
- 2. Take out appropriate number of blocks
- 3. Assemble the entire patio mount

Installation Steps:

- 1. Locate suitable mount location
- 2. Transport mount and blocks
- 3. Place mat on mounting location (if applicable)
- Place mount at mounting location so LNBF is opposite ballast
- 5. Place cap blocks on mount
- 6. Level mast and tighten hardware with 7/16" wrench
- 7. Place dish on mast

13. Pole

Supplies:

- Pole
- Shovel
- Two 50 lb. bags concrete
- Two gallons water in bucket

Installation Steps:

- 1. Unplug the receiver
- 2. Double-check no other mount can be used
- 3. Verify area is marked with clear LOS
- Carefully place dish with attached burial cable on the ground
- Bring temporary mount back to vehicle and all pole mount supplies to the mount site
- 6. Dig the hole 3' x 7', unless in a 4' market
- 7. Pour one 50-lb. bag of concrete in the hole
- 8. Pour one gallon of water in the hole
- 9. Repeat with the second 50-lb. bag of concrete
- 10. Slightly stir the concrete with the pole
- 11. Level the pole and let concrete dry
- 12. Starting at the house, dig a trench, run burial cable, and cover with dirt
- 13. Verify pole is still level once concrete is dry
- 14. Place dish on mast
- 15. Attach sweep to pole with zip ties
- 16. Fill hole with dirt
- 17. Attach cable to pole with zip ties
